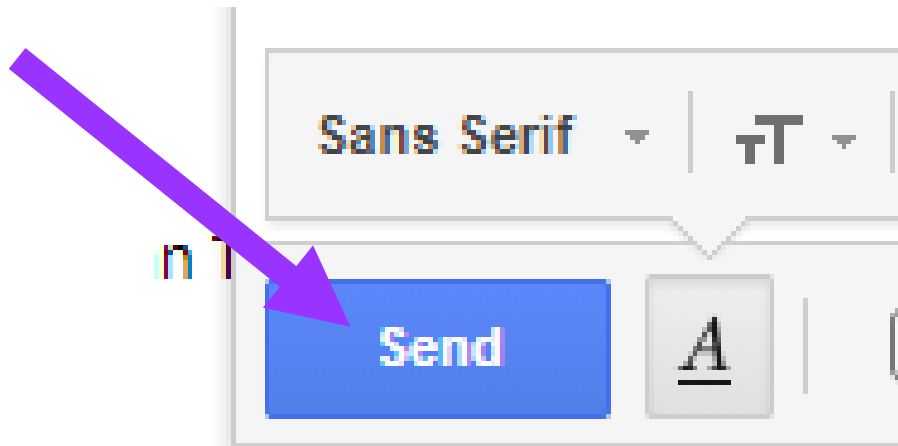
All this work the Builders are doing, and we still have 56 open jobs.
